- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the notice requirements for closure of a highway 2 and to provide a civil penalty for failure to comply with a closure. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 31-4-14.2 be amended to read as follows: 5 31-4-14.2. Notice to the public that a state trunk highway is closed or its use is restricted 6 shall be given in one or more of the following forms: 7 (1) Erection of suitable barriers upon the highway to restrict or prohibit travel; 8 (2) Post Issue warning and notice of the condition of the highway for travel in generally 9 available media outlets;
- 12 (4) Place warning devices on the highway; or

- 14 Section 2. That § 31-4-14.3 be amended to read as follows:

or direction, or barrier placed or given under § 31-4-14.2 is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.

2 Any unauthorized presence on a closed highway is prima facie evidence of a violation of this

3 <u>section</u>. If, as a result of a violation of this section for failure to observe a notice provided

4 pursuant to subdivision 31-4-14.2(1), (4), or (5) § 31-4-14.2, any agency of the State of South

Dakota or any governmental subdivision incurs any costs for the purpose of rescuing the

violator, any passengers, or the vehicle operated by the violator, the violator is civilly liable to

7 the State of South Dakota for such costs, subject to a civil action by the State of South Dakota

in circuit court for the recovery of a civil penalty of one thousand dollars and the actual cost of

9 <u>any such rescue, in an amount</u> not to exceed ten thousand dollars.
