SENATE BILL NO. 7

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding prohibited activities
- 2 near polling places.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 12-18-3 be amended to read:
- 5 12-18-3. Except for sample ballots and materials and, or for supplies necessary for the
- 6 conduct of the election, no <u>a</u> person may <u>not</u>, in any <u>a</u> polling place or, within or on any building
- 7 in which a polling place is located, or within one hundred feet from any of an entrance leading
- 8 into a polling place, maintain:
- 9 (1) <u>Maintain</u> a campaign office or public address system, or use;
- 10 (2) <u>Use</u> any communication or photographic device in a manner which that repeatedly
- 11 distracts, interrupts, or intimidates any voter or election worker, or display:
- 12 (3) <u>Display a campaign posters, signs, or other campaign materials or by any like means</u>
- 13 solicit any poster or sign; or
- 14 (4) <u>Solicit</u> votes for or against any person-or, political party, or position on a question
 15 submitted or which that may be submitted.



Insertions into existing statutes are indicated by <u>underscores</u>. Deletions from existing statutes are indicated by overstrikes. No <u>A</u> person may <u>not</u> engage in any practice which <u>that</u> interferes with <u>the</u> <u>a</u> voter's free access to the polls or <u>that</u> disrupts the administration of <u>the</u> <u>a</u> polling place, <u>or</u>. <u>A</u> person may not conduct any petition signature gathering, on the day of an election, <u>inside or</u> within one hundred feet of a polling place. For the purposes of this section, the term, polling place, means <u>a designated place voters may go to vote on the day of the election or go to vote absentee.</u>

- 6 This section does not prohibit a voter from wearing clothing or any campaign button that
- 7 expresses support for or opposition to a political candidate, political issue, or ballot question
- 8 while lawfully present inside or within one hundred feet of a polling place. This section does
- 9 not prohibit any person from displaying a campaign poster or sign on that person's private
- 10 property or personal vehicle within one hundred feet of a polling place so long as the property
- 11 or vehicle is otherwise lawfully present.
- 12 A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
