- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide certain restrictions regarding the passing of a
- 2 bicycle.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 32-26 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 The driver of any motor vehicle overtaking a bicycle proceeding in the same direction shall
- 7 pass the bicycle as required by § 32-26-26 and shall leave a safe distance, but in no case less
- 8 than three feet clearance, when passing the bicycle. The driver of the motor vehicle shall
- 9 maintain the clearance until safely past the overtaken bicycle. A violation of this section is a
- 10 Class 2 misdemeanor.
