

2024 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 73

Introduced by: Senator Schoenbeck

An Act to provide that the presiding officer of the Senate is required to sign each enrolled bill.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 2-7-20 be AMENDED:

5 **2-7-20.** The original copy of each enrolled bill shall be signed by the president 6 presiding officer of the Senate, secretary of the Senate, speaker of the House of 7 Representatives, and chief clerk of the House of Representatives and presented to the 8 Governor. If the Governor approves the bill, the Governor shall sign and transmit it to the 9 secretary of state who shall deliver a photocopy of the signature page to the code counsel to be used in preparing copy for session laws. The secretary of state shall provide a 10 permanent form of binder for the original enrolled bills and the bills vetoed with the veto 11 12 message attached. The secretary of state shall also provide the code counsel with a 13 photocopy of the signature page of each vetoed bill and the veto message.
