An Act to make an appropriation for the design, renovation, and construction of a multi-purpose facility at the Cottonwood Field Station and to declare an emergency.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$6,000,000, to
- 6 the Board of Regents, for purposes of contracting for the design, renovation, and construction
- 7 of a multi-purpose facility at the Cottonwood Field Station of the Agricultural Experiment
- 8 Station, located in Jackson County, South Dakota, together with furnishings and equipment,
- 9 including heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks,
- 10 parking, landscaping, architectural and engineering services, and such other facilities,
- services, and actions necessary to complete the project. The cost of the project is \$6,000,000,
- 12 <u>subject to any adjustments permitted by this Act.</u>
- 13 **Section 2.** The cost estimates contained in this Act are stated in 2021 values. The Board of
- 14 Regents may adjust the cost estimates to reflect project inflation, as measured by the Building
- 15 Cost Index, reported by the Engineering News Record, and make additional expenditures
- 16 required to comply with regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act, or expend
- 17 additional sums received pursuant to section 3 of this Act. Adjustments to design and
- 18 construction cost estimates for the project may not exceed one hundred twenty-five percent
- of the estimated project cost, as stated in section 1 of this Act.
- 20 **Section 3.** The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any funds obtained for
- 21 <u>the projects authorized in this Act from federal sources, donations, or any other external</u>
- 22 sources, all of which comprise a special fund for the benefitted project.
- 23 **Section 4.** The administration of the design, renovation, and construction of the project
- 24 authorized in this Act is under the general charge and supervision of the Bureau of
- 25 <u>Administration, as provided for in chapter 5-14.</u>

- 1 **Section 5.** The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the
- 2 <u>state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
- 3 **Section 6.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 4 <u>revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 5 **Section 7.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 6 <u>existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in</u>
- 7 <u>full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
