- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the continuing education requirements for certain
- 2 veterinarians over the age of sixty-five.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 36-12-19.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 36-12-19.1. All registered veterinarians licensed pursuant to this chapter shall be required
- 6 to complete annual courses of study in subjects related to the practice of veterinary medicine.
- 7 The Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners may, however, waive the continuing education
- 8 requirement in the case of a certified illness or, undue hardship, or for veterinarians over the age
- 9 of sixty-five years and not engaged in acts constituting the practice of veterinary medicine as
- defined in § 36-12-1. The board may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to govern the
- 11 minimum amount and type of continuing education in veterinary medicine to be required
- annually of each licensed veterinarian seeking renewal of his registration pursuant to § 36-12-
- 13 19.
