- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide certain provisions regarding liability against
- 2 public entities that prohibit firearms on their premises.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Any public entity that prohibits firearms on or within the person's or entity's premises is
- 6 liable for civil damages resulting from any injury that is proximately caused by a crime of
- 7 violence as defined in § 22-1-2 against a person who is unable to carry a firearm due to the
- 8 prohibition while the injured person was on the premises at the time of the injury. For purposes
- 9 of this section the public entity is deemed to have waived the common law doctrine of sovereign
- 10 immunity and is deemed to have consented to suit in the same manner that any other party may
- 11 be sued.
- Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Any person who is injured while on the premises of a public entity that prohibits firearms
- on or within the premises may recover damages if the injury was proximately caused by a crime

of violence as defined in § 22-1-2 against the injured person who was unable to carry a firearm

- 2 due to the prohibition at the time of the injury.
- 3 Section 3. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 Any person entitled to bring an action under this Act may recover all of the following:
- 5 (1) Economic damages;
- 6 (2) Noneconomic damages;
- 7 (3) Exemplary damages; and
- 8 (4) Attorneys' fees.
