- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow shareholders of corporations to represent
- 2 corporations in property tax appeals at the Office of Hearing Examiners.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 10-11 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- After notice and unanimous vote of the shareholders, a shareholder of a subchapter S
- 7 corporation that has ten or fewer shareholders, may represent the corporation during a property
- 8 tax appeal, pursuant to chapter 10-11, to the Office of Hearing Examiners. The designated
- 9 shareholder does not need to be a licensed attorney. In order to exercise this option, the
- 10 corporation shall present to the Office of Hearing Examiners, the name and mailing address of
- each of the shareholders, proof of notice to the shareholders, and a copy of the minutes and
- motion or resolution reflecting the unanimous vote authorizing the designated shareholder to
- 13 represent the corporation in the appeal.
