- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions relating to the reimbursement
- 2 of referring counties for certain mental health services.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 27A-11A-13 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 27A-11A-13. If the board of mental illness finds that a person meets the criteria in § 27A-
- 6 10-9.1, the board shall enter a finding, based on the criteria in § 28-13-3, regarding the county
- 7 of residence of the person or a finding that the person is not a resident of this state. If a person
- 8 is determined to be a resident of this state, the board shall find that the person is a resident of
- 9 the county in which the person geographically resides regardless of whether the person is a
- 10 member of an Indian tribe, is affiliated with a tribe, or resides on an Indian reservation within
- 11 <u>the county.</u>
- 12 Section 2. That chapter 27A-13 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read
- 13 as follows:
- 14 Any reimbursement by the county of residence that is required in this title shall be made
- 15 within thirty days after notice by the referring county to the county of residence that



1 reimbursement is due. Reimbursement shall be made by the county of residence to the referring 2 county regardless of whether the person is Native American, is a member of or may be affiliated 3 with an Indian tribe, or resides on an Indian reservation in this state. Reimbursement shall be 4 made by the county of residence to the referring county regardless of whether third-party 5 coverage is or may be available to cover the reimbursable costs, expenses, and fees incurred by 6 the referring county in carrying out the provisions of this title. If third-party coverage is or may 7 be available to the county of residence, the county of residence may seek reimbursement from 8 the third party after reimbursing the referring county.
