- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise provisions related to human trafficking.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 22-49-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 22-49-1. No person may recruit, harbor, transport, provide, or obtain, by any means, another
- 5 person, eighteen years of age or older, knowing that force, fraud, or coercion will be used to
- 6 cause the person to engage in prostitution, forced labor, or involuntary servitude. Nor may any
- 7 person benefit financially or by receiving anything of value, including services, from
- 8 participation in a venture that has engaged in acts set forth in this section. Any violation of this
- 9 section constitutes the crime of human trafficking.
- Section 2. That § 22-49-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 11 22-49-2. If the acts or the venture set forth in § 22-49-1:
- 12 (1) Involve committing or attempting to commit kidnaping;
- 13 (2) Involve a victim person under the age of sixteen eighteen years;
- 14 (3) Involve prostitution or procurement for prostitution; or

- 2 any person guilty has committed human trafficking in the first degree, which is a Class 2 felony.
- 3 Section 3. That § 22-49-3 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 22-49-3. A person is guilty of human trafficking in the second degree if that person:
- Recruits, harbors, transports, provides, or obtains, by any means, another person knowing that force, fraud, or coercion will be used to cause the person to engage in prostitution, forced labor, or involuntary servitude; or
- 8 (2) Benefits financially or by receiving anything of value, including services, from participation in a venture that has engaged in acts set forth in this section.
- Human trafficking in the second degree is a Class 4 felony.
