3 WHEREAS, in the town of Kimball, South Dakota, stands the South Dakota Tractor

- 5 WHEREAS, in the twenty years since its opening, there have been eleven building projects.
- 6 <u>Starting with just twenty-two tractors, the museum now boasts much more. There are cars,</u>

7 farm equipment, horse equipment, a 1917 derby truck, a one-room school, a blacksmith shop,

- 8 and a visitor center; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Tractor Museum is run by approximately forty local volunteers overseen

10 by a seven-member board. Every year the museum opens in the middle of May and remains

11 open through September. People can visit the museum any time of the year by appointment;

- 14 will donations are welcomed. The Tractor Museum stands just south of I-90 at Exit 284:
