Senate Concurrent Resolution 602

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, To invite responsible gun owners from Virginia to 2 relocate to South Dakota.

3 WHEREAS, we the people of South Dakota have enshrined in our state Constitution the

4 <u>belief that all men are born equally free and independent, that all men have certain inherent</u>

5 rights, and that those rights include enjoying and defending life and liberty, acquiring and

6 protecting property, and pursuing happiness; and

7 WHEREAS, we the people of South Dakota have enshrined in our state Constitution the

- 8 right to be secure in our persons, houses, papers and effects, against unreasonable searches
- 9 and seizures; and
- 10 WHEREAS, we the people of South Dakota have enshrined in our state Constitution the

11 right to bear arms in defense of ourselves and the state; and

12 WHEREAS, we the people of South Dakota live by the words of our Constitution--we value

13 the rights granted to us by that document and by the second amendment to the Constitution

- 14 of the United States; and
- 15 WHEREAS, we the people of South Dakota value and jealously guard our right to keep and

16 <u>bear arms--a right that includes constitutional carry, capital</u>capitol carry, and a long and proud

17 <u>tradition of hunting and participation in the shooting sports; and</u>

18 <u>WHEREAS</u>, we the people of South Dakota recognize that, in other states, such basic rights 19 are under assault by governmental bodies more intent on infringing upon the freedom of their

- 20 <u>citizens than protecting and preserving it:</u>
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature of the

22 <u>State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that we the people</u>

23 of South Dakota invite the responsible gunowners of the Commonwealth of Virginia to

24 consider relocating to the 40th state where, in the shadow of Mount Rushmore, America's

1	shrine of democracy, we will welcome you to experience our bustling cities and endless
2	prairies, share in our crystal clear waters, play on our majestic hills, marvel at our unparalleled
3	beauty and bounty, and absorb all that is our boundless wonder, and more importantly we
4	will welcome you to live under the banner of unwavering support for the most precious rights
5	and freedoms guaranteed to all by and through the United States Constitution and the
6	Constitution of this state; and
7	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the secretary of the Senate arrange for copies of this

8 resolution to be forwarded to the governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the president

9 pro tempore of the Senate of Virginia, the speaker of the Virginia House of Delegates, and

10 <u>the editor of the Richmond Times Dispatch for publication.</u>
