- 4 Dakota state government's susceptibility to corruption, cronyism, and nepotism:
- 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Ninety-Second Legislature
- of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that we
- 7 respectfully request that a special prosecutor be appointed by the South Dakota attorney general
- 8 to prosecute, both civilly and criminally, all losses that the South Dakota taxpayers have
- 9 sustained as a result of the above-mentioned scandals.
