## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing and submitting to the electors at the next general election
- an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, related to terms of office
- 3 for members of the Legislature.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE
- 5 OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 6 Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following amendment to
- 7 Article III, section 6 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, as set forth in section 2
- 8 of this Joint Resolution, which is hereby agreed to, shall be submitted to the electors of the state
- 9 for approval.
- Section 2. That Article III, section 6 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- § 6. The terms term of office of the members of the Legislature shall be two four years; they.
- 13 The members shall receive for their services the salary fixed by law under the provisions of § 2
- of article XXI of this Constitution, and five cents for every mile of necessary travel in going to

- and returning from the place of meeting of the Legislature on the most usual route.
- 2 No A person may not serve more than four two consecutive terms or a total of eight
- 3 consecutive years in the senate and more than four two consecutive terms or a total of eight
- 4 consecutive years in the house of representatives. However, this restriction does not apply to
- 5 partial terms to which a legislator may be appointed The limitation under this section does not
- 6 include any term for which the Governor made an appointment to fill a vacancy under § 10 of
- 7 article III of this Constitution.
- 8 A regular session of the Legislature shall be held each year and shall not exceed forty
- 9 legislative days, excluding Sundays, holidays, and legislative recess, except in cases of
- 10 impeachment, and members. Members of the Legislature shall receive no other pay or
- perquisites except salary and mileage during a regular session.
- Section 3. Notwithstanding § 2-1-12, the effective date of this amendment is January 1,
- 13 2023.
