AMEND Senate Bill No. 419

House Bill No. 5*

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-39-102(d), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

- (5) Wrongful death of an unborn child at any stage of gestation in utero when an abortion-inducing drug is sent directly to a patient by a defendant via courier, delivery, or mail service in violation of § 63-6-1103(b).
 - (A) For purposes of this subdivision (d)(5), "abortion-inducing drug" means mifepristone or misoprostol. This subdivision (d)(5) does not prohibit the lawful use of mifepristone or misoprostol by a pharmacist or physician.
 - (B) This subdivision (d)(5) does not apply to:
 - (i) A pharmacist;
 - (ii) A physician;
 - (iii) A motor carrier or freight forwarder, as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 13102; or
 - (iv) An air carrier, as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 40102.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2025, the public welfare requiring it, and applies to a cause of action filed on or after that date.
