SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (004802): Requires the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (TACIR) to study the economic impact on counties that are required to provide ambulance services (services), which counties provide services directly or franchise such services, which municipalities provide such services, and whether policy changes may benefit the overall health and delivery of services in this state.

Furthermore, TACIR is required to study emergency and non-emergency transport reimbursement from commercial payors, Medicare, Medicaid, and the way counties and municipalities fund the deficit at which these services operate. Requires TACIR to complete such studies utilizing its existing resources and to report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the chairs of certain legislative committees and the legislative librarian.

- According to TACIR, the study may be performed utilizing existing staff and resources; therefore, any increase in state expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
