HB 117 - SB 337

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from one time to once every three years, the frequency of in-service training that teachers must complete regarding the detection, intervention, prevention, and treatment of human trafficking in which the victim is a child.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-6-3004 requires teachers to complete one-time training on human trafficking when the victim is a child through the viewing of a video recording approved by local education agencies (LEAs).
- It is assumed that LEAs already have the necessary resources and video recording required for the training and can accomplish the training during the normal course of business; therefore, increased training will not result in any significant fiscal impact to local government.
