SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits a peer supporter during a critical incident stress management intervention from being compelled to testify or divulge certain communications with a person participating in the crisis intervention. Specifies these communications are considered confidential.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- In civil or criminal proceeding, some communications between specific relationships are considered privileged and inadmissible. These include married persons, clergy, psychiatrists, press, and interpreters.
- Excluding a peer supporter during a critical incident stress management intervention from being compelled to testify or divulge certain communications with a person participating in the crisis intervention will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
