SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits a county employee from serving on the county legislative body (CLB) of the county for which the person is employed.

Provides the following exceptions: a CLB member who is a county employee on the effective date of this act may serve the remainder of the member's term, and a CLB member who is reelected to the CLB on or after the effective date of this act without any interruption in holding such office may continue as a CLB member.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The proposed legislation will have no significant impact on the total number of county employees or CLB members, nor on the length of term of CLB members who violate the prohibition; therefore, it will not result in any significant fiscal impact to local government.
