FISCAL NOTE

HB 213 - SB 257

January 26, 2021

SUMMARY OF BILL: Defines “veterinary facility” as a building, place, or mobile unit from which the practice of veterinary medicine is conducted. Authorizes members of the Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners (Board) to be appointed for successive terms.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Board can accommodate the proposed changes utilizing existing resources; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health-related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board had an annual surplus of \$202,352 in FY18-19, an annual surplus of \$210,596 in FY19-20, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$1,171,048 on June 30, 2020.
