HB 643 - SB 579

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Removes law enforcement as a transportation option for individuals with developmental disabilities, mental illnesses, and serious emotional disturbances.

### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

#### **NOT SIGNIFICANT**

## Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation deletes the provision in Tenn. Code Ann. § 33-2-501 that includes law enforcement as one of the options to transport individuals with developmental disabilities, mental illnesses, and serious emotional disturbances to the appropriate facility for services and/or treatment.
- Currently, Tenn. Code Ann. § 33-6-406(a) and § 33-6-901(a)(1) require sheriffs to transport such individuals for both emergency and non-emergency involuntary admissions for inpatient treatment.
- The proposed legislation will not impact any programs or policies of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
