HB 705 - SB 1047

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Makes several non-substantive changes to the Non-Smoker Protection Act. Establishes that smoking includes using a vapor product that aerosols or vaporizes nicotine, or any other substance, to the person inhaling from the device; and furthermore, smoking from such a device is prohibited in enclosed spaces, non-exempt from the Act.

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (007167):** Deletes and replaces language in the original bill without making any substantive changes to the legislation.

- In general, using a vaping device is currently prohibited anywhere smoking is prohibited.
