SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Makes several non-substantive changes to the Non-Smoker Protection Act. Establishes that smoking includes using a vapor product that aerosols or vaporizes nicotine, or any other substance, to the person inhaling from the device; and furthermore, smoking from such a device is prohibited in enclosed spaces, non-exempt from the Act.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (007167): Deletes and replaces language in the original bill without making any substantive changes to the legislation.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- In general, using a vaping device is currently prohibited anywhere smoking is prohibited.
- This legislation codifies current practices in Tennessee.
- This legislation is estimated to have no significant impact on state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- This legislation is estimated to have no significant impact to jobs or commerce in this state.
