HB 779 – SB 1354

March 7, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits local governments from limiting access, by ordinance, resolution, or any other means, to the court system for traffic citations issued using unmanned traffic enforcement cameras.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Municipal Technical Advisory Service (MTAS) reports that most municipalities allow individuals who receive traffic camera citations to challenge the validity of such citations in court.
- Any additional increases in court challenges pursuant to the provisions of the bill are estimated to be not significant and can be absorbed within the existing resources of the courts.
- The provisions of the bill are not expected to significantly impact citation revenue or court fees.
