FISCAL NOTE

HB 1170 - SB 1242

March 16, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Commission to adopt guidelines and materials instructing law enforcement officers on the best practices for recognizing and responding to a medical crisis involving a person under arrest or under the care or supervision of the law enforcement officer. Specifies that the guidelines and materials must not require an officer to undergo specialized medical training for the purposes of becoming POST certified.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The POST Commission can develop the required guidelines and materials within existing personnel and resources.
- Law enforcement officers will not be required to undergo specialized training as a result of the proposed legislation.
- Any increase in expenditures to law enforcement agencies to implement such guidelines and materials is estimated to be not significant.
