FISCAL NOTE

SB 883 - HB 1320

March 9, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates the *Long-Acting Birth Control Information Act*. Requires the Department of Health (DOH) to administer a program to improve access to long-acting reversible contraceptives (LARCs) for women. Requires the program to include, but not be limited to: training for family planning centers regarding LARC methods; counseling strategies and managing side effects; education and outreach to the public about the availability, effectiveness, and safety of LARCs; and a study for making as many contraceptive methods as possible available over-the-counter and directly through pharmacies.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the DOH, the services required by the proposed legislation are currently in place; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- DOH can perform the required study utilizing existing resources without a significant increase in expenditures.
