SUMMARY OF BILL: Renames Columbus Day as Indigenous Peoples' Day.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-4-105(a)(3), the Governor may, at the Governor's discretion, substitute the Friday after Thanksgiving Day in place of Columbus Day as a legal holiday, for purposes of closing state offices. Renaming this holiday will not impact the Governor's ability to substitute holidays.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact state or local government operations.
