SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends the termination date of the Tennessee Massage Licensure Board to June 30, 2028. Under the Tennessee Governmental Entity Review Law, the Board is scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This bill continues an existing entity at its current funding level.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 9-4-5117(a), all health-related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board had a deficit of \$46,386 in FY19-20, a surplus of \$121,963 in FY20-21, and a cumulative reserve surplus of \$770,932 as of June 30, 2021.
