HB 2103 - SB 2118

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes the word “felony” wherever it appears in Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-35-122, in accordance with the Public Safety Act of 2016.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Public Safety Act of 2016 modified the grading of theft and theft-related offenses under Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-14-105.
- The proposed legislation deletes the word “felony” in Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-35-122 as it relates to non-violent property offenses.
- The proposed legislation will align the grading of non-violent property offenses in Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-35-122 with the Public Safety Act of 2016.
- The legislation will not significantly impact the Department of Correction’s operations, as any cost or savings were accounted for in the Public Safety Act of 2016.
- There will be no fiscal impact on the Administrative Office of the Courts, the District Attorneys General Conference, or the District Public Defenders Conference.
