# FISCAL NOTE

HB 2254 – SB 2445

February 14, 2024

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases the composition of the Tennessee Child Fatality Prevention Team (state team) by adding three residents of Tennessee who are the parent of a child under the age of 18. Requires the state team to distribute its annual report to each local education agency (LEA) and to the Board of the Tennessee Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

## Assumptions:

- Pursuant to the proposed legislation, the three new members will serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for travel and other expenses incurred in attending each meeting and performing other duties.
- The state's team currently meets quarterly and via virtual means; therefore, it is assumed that any increase in state expenditures for mileage reimbursement for the additional members will be not significant.
- The state team's annual report is currently available on the Tennessee Department of Health's website; therefore, it is able to be distributed to each LEA and the Board of the Tennessee Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics without any increase in expenditures.
