SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires only an applicant for a marriage license who is under 18 years of age to include the name and current address of the applicant's parents, guardian, or next of kin.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-3-104(a), every applicant for a marriage license must provide the names and addresses of the parents, guardian, or next of kin of both parties.
- The proposed legislation would remove this requirement for all applicants except those under the age of 18.
- It is assumed that any modifications to marriage license applications will be made utilizing existing staff and resources, resulting in no significant increase in local expenditures.
- The proposed legislation will not have any significant impact on the number of marriage licenses issued; therefore, any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
