FISCAL NOTE

HB 2347 - SB 2463

February 24, 2022

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Comptroller of the Treasury (COT), in conjunction with the Division of TennCare (Division) and Department of Health (DOH), to study the use of temporary staffing provided by healthcare staffing agencies in long-term care facilities. Requires the Comptroller of the Treasury to deliver a report on the study to the Speaker of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Legislative Librarian by January 1, 2023.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed study can be conducted by COT, using administrative support from the Division and DOH, utilizing existing staff and resources from all three entities.
- Any increase in expenditures necessary to compile and submit the report by January 1, 2023 will not be significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The provisions of the proposed legislation will not impact jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
