**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 2144 - HB 2364**

February 16, 2022

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the legislative body of a municipality to designate a committee of the legislative body as the planning commission.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §13-4-101(a):
  - The chief legislative body of any municipality may create and establish a municipal planning commission consisting of between five and ten members, one of which shall be the mayor of the municipality or the mayor's designee and one of which shall be a member chosen by and from the chief legislative body. All other members shall be appointed by the mayor.
  - The chief legislative body may determine compensation for members of the planning commission.
  - Such compensation may not be counted against a salary limitation established by charter or otherwise.
- Any designation by the legislative body will occur during a regularly scheduled meeting of that body and the legislative body already determines compensation for the planning commission; therefore, authorizing such a legislative body to designate a committee of that body as the planning commission will not result in any significant impact to local government.
