FISCAL NOTE

HB 2386 - SB 2599

February 29, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a law enforcement officer to execute a search warrant for medical records or a test to determine the alcohol and drug content of a person's blood anywhere in the state.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- It is assumed that the proposed legislation would authorize a law enforcement officer to execute a search warrant for medical records or a search to determine a person's blood alcohol and drug content outside of what would otherwise be considered the officer's established jurisdiction.
- Expanding law enforcement officers' authority to execute such actions in this manner is not estimated to significantly impact the operations or workload of any state or local agency; therefore, any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
