SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires an employer to state the minimum and maximum salary or hourly wage for a job, promotion, or transfer opportunity advertised within this state.

Defines an "employer" as an individual or entity that employs 50 or more employees and includes this state and its political subdivisions.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Department of Human Resources currently provides wage information on its website for all positions.
- This legislation will not significantly impact state or local government operations or wages offered by such entities.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:
