## FISCAL NOTE

HB 2687 - SB 2582

February 16, 2024

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Revises the family life curriculum to include instruction on human trafficking of children and internet crimes against children. Requires the Tennessee Joint Task Force on Children's Justice and Child Sexual Abuse (Task Force) to annually recommend to the Department of Education (DOE) age-appropriate curricula for the instruction, which the DOE must share annually with local education agencies (LEAs) and public charter schools for their use. Requires LEAs and public charter schools to submit to the Department of Children's Services each school year the curriculum selected and the contact information of the individual providing the instruction.
