SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from two to three hours per year, and from ten to fifteen hours per five years, the amount of training or continuing education courses on domestic violence or child abuse all judges involved in child custody proceedings are required to complete.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 36-6-702(c), the training and continuing education courses may be offered in person or virtually by the Administrative Office of the Courts in conjunction with the annual meetings of the judicial conferences.
- The increase in required trainings and continuing education will therefore not result in any increase in expenditures associated with compensating judges for their attendance.
- The proposed legislation will not have any significant impact on the proceedings of the court system.
