SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends the termination date of the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners to June 30, 2026. Under the *Tennessee Governmental Entity Review Law*, the Board is scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2021.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This bill continues an existing entity at its current funding level.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health-related boards are required to be self-supporting over any two-year period.
- According to the Department of Health, the Board experienced a surplus of \$4,307 in FY18-19, a deficit of \$49,084 in FY19-20, and had a cumulative reserve balance of \$270,578 on June 30, 2020.
