FISCAL NOTE

SB 66

January 23, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a seven member special joint task force to study issues relating to state mental health facilities. Requires the task force to report its finding and recommendations to the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate and the Health Committee of the House of Representatives no later than February 15, 2020, at which time the task force will cease to exist.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The seven member task force will consist of General Assembly members.
- Each meeting will take place only on days in which the General Assembly has a scheduled floor session or standing committee meeting; therefore, no additional per diem would be required and any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services can provide assistance to the task force within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
