# FISCAL NOTE

SB 200 - HB 304

January 20, 2023

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires establishments that have more than \$500,000 in gross sales of alcoholic beverages per calendar year to maintain at least one unexpired four-milligram dose of the opiate antagonist naloxone hydrochloride suspended in a one-tenth-milliliter nasal spray in an easily accessible location on the premises as a condition of receiving or renewing a liquor-by-the-drink license.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

#### NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation does not require funding or reimbursement for the cost of naloxone hydrochloride.
- Any impact on the number of licenses issued or sales of alcoholic beverages will be not significant.
