## FISCAL NOTE

HB 203 – SB 209

February 19, 2021

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the Fish and Wildlife Commission of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) to promulgate rules to establish quiet zones on waterways and to enforce any such promulgated rule.

### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

#### **NOT SIGNIFICANT**

## **Assumptions:**

- Currently, the TWRA employs full-time and part-time boating officers to enforce the various statutes and rules relative to recreational boating.
- Such officers patrol Tennessee's waters each day during peak boating season.
- When noise complaints are currently made, it is assumed that the local law enforcement officers receive the call.
- This legislation will not increase the number of such complaints.
- It is assumed that existing TWRA boating officers can enforce any quiet zones established by rule by the Agency.
- This legislation will have no significant fiscal impact on state or local government.
