SUMMARY OF BILL: Allows children aged 17 or younger to accompany parents or legal guardians into polling places.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 2-7-103(e) currently allows children younger than 17 to accompany parents or legal guardians into polling places. The proposed legislation would expand this to also include children 17 years of age.
- The proposed legislation will not create an increase in expenditures to state or local election commissions.
