FISCAL NOTE

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from 30 days to 60 days, the length of time within which an individual may request a hearing, pursuant to the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, following a denial of an individual's application for an employee permit authorized by the Alcoholic Beverage Commission.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The denied applicant is only eligible to request a hearing if the applicant fails to meet the requirements pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 57-3-703(a), but is otherwise eligible for a permit.
- Lengthening the period of time by 30 days when a denied applicant is eligible to request a hearing with an administrative law judge or hearing officer in an attempt to reverse the initial denial will not significantly impact the number of hearings or the number of authorized permits. Any fiscal impact will be not significant.
