**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 619 - SB 636**

March 2, 2017

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Archaeological Advisory Council membership be composed of three persons with historically proven Native American descent, instead of being at least one-quarter blooded. Requires one of the three Council members be a member of the Native American Indian Association of Tennessee. Requires the Native American Indian Association of Tennessee to be contacted prior to Native American Indian gravesites being excavated.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Currently there are three Native American members on the Archaeological Advisory Council (AAC). The number of Native American members or the total members of the Council is not changed by the proposed legislation.
- Requiring the Native American Indian Association of Tennessee be contacted prior to excavation of Native American Indian gravesites will not result in a significant state or local fiscal impact.
