HB 173 - SB 894

SUMMARY OF BILL: Clarifies that state drug laws under title 39, chapter 17, part 4, and title 53, chapter 11, parts 3 and 4, preempt the entire field of determining the appropriate sanction for drug offenses.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation expressly voids ordinances passed by Davidson County and Shelby County. Contacts from Davidson County report that the proposed legislation will not significantly impact local government operations.
- It is assumed that the proposed legislation will not significantly impact Shelby County operations.
