SB 1227 - HB 1346

SUMMARY OF BILL: Revises the meaning of sexual activity for the purposes of offenses related to the sexual exploitation of children.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-17-1002(8)(G), one of the acts included in the definition of sexual activity is lascivious exhibition of the female breast or the genitals, buttocks, anus, or pubic or rectal area of any person.
- The proposed legislation revises such act to include exhibition of the breast, genitals, buttocks, anus or pubic or rectal area of any minor that can be reasonably construed as being for the purpose of the sexual arousal or gratification of the defendant or another.
- Any impact to state incarceration resulting from the revision of such act is estimated to be not significant.
