FISCAL NOTE

HB 188 – SB 1287

February 14, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Removes a reference to the *Cover Tennessee Act of 2016* that established an exception to the prohibition of managed health insurance issuers contacting or employing an agent to directly contact a patient of a physician's practice in an effort to change a referral for services to another provider if the managed health insurance issuer has contracted with the physician.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The *Cover Tennessee Act of 2006* was repealed, effective June 30, 2015; therefore, the reference to the *Act* is obsolete and no longer necessary.
- Any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The proposed legislation will not impact commerce or jobs in Tennessee.
