**HB 1324 - SB 1424**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires any juvenile court proceeding involving allegations that the juvenile was illegally in possession of a firearm to be given priority in scheduling.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**
