FISCAL NOTE

HB 1002 - SB 1500

March 1, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires, by January 1, 2024, local law enforcement agencies and departments to conduct an inventory of all sexual assault collection kits (SAKs) being stored by the agency or department. Requires, by January 15, 2024, those agencies and departments to submit a written report to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) containing the number of untested SAKs in their possession and the dates the SAKs were collected. Requires, by July 1, 2024, the TBI to prepare and transmit a report to the Speaker of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives containing the number of untested SAKs being stored by each county and law enforcement agency or department and the dates the SAKs were collected.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the Tennessee Sheriffs Association and the Tennessee Association of the Chiefs of Police, local law enforcement agencies and departments can take the inventory and compile and submit the report utilizing existing resources. It is assumed that any relevant counties can do the same.
- According to the TBI, the bureau can prepare and transmit the report utilizing existing resources.
- Any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
