FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1510 – HB 2164

March 9, 2018

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires family life education to include instruction on detection, intervention, prevention, and treatment of child sexual abuse. Excludes family life instructors not employed directly by the LEA from liability for parental complaints related to such instruction.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (014131): Deletes and replaces all language after the enacting clause without making any substantive changes.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- No change in Basic Education Program (BEP) funding formula.
- The additional instruction will be added to family life education within the normal course of business.
- Based on information provided by the Department of Education, the State Board of Education, the Department of Children's Services, and the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, any fiscal impact associated with including instruction on detection, intervention, prevention, and treatment of child sexual abuse in family life curriculum is estimated to be not significant.
